NOTICE: September street cleaning was not completed, due to lack of funds. We are planning on having the streets cleaned again in May of 2015. If funds are available we will do it again in September 2015. Please help keep our streets clean by picking up the litter and remove weeds in front of your home.

REMINDER: If you live on a Snow Emergency Route, listen to the radio or TV they will announce the Snow Emergency. When the Snow Emergency is in effect remove your vehicles from the street, until you have been told it is okay to return. **Absolutely No Parking On The Sidewalks !**

Sidewalks are to be cleared 24" and must be shoveled within 12 hours after the snow stops falling. Violators will be fined.

GARBAGE: is not to be placed on the curb until 5:00 pm the night before! Large item pickups are on Thursdays only. TV's and computers are not allowed to be placed on the curb for pickup. They must be taken to a recycling facility! Every third Saturday the Solid Waste Authority on Blackbridge Rd will accept these items from 9:00 to 1:00pm. Also place your address on your garbage and recycle bin. So they can be returned during high winds.

TRICK OR TREAT will be held on October 31, 2014 between the hours of 6:00pm to 8:00pm. A costume Parade will be held on November 1, 2014 starting at 5:30pm. Anyone interested is asked to be at Liberty Fire Company; the children and adults will march South on Duke St. to the Kauffman Playground where there will be a community Bon-fire. There will be 1st and 2nd place prizes given for best costumes in the following age groups: 1-3, 4-7, 8-10 and 11-12 years of age. Refreshments will be provided by the Recreation Committee. Please bring your own lawn chairs.

TREES AND BUSHES: You must have your bushes clear of the sidewalks. Trees must be trimmed to a height of 7' over sidewalks and 14' over the street.
