### **-STORMWATER NEWS**

Storm drains in the borough Streets are for collection of rainwater only. Any discharge to the storm drains not composed entirely of rainwater is considered an illicit discharge with some exceptions.

With warmer weather on the horizon, please remove any remaining salt and cinders from your sidewalk to prevent them from being washed into the storm sewer system and then ultimately into streams and creeks.

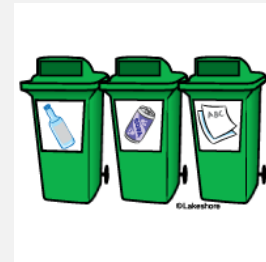
