ORDINANCE NO. 2022 - 1

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE VII, "TRAFFIC CODE," OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF NORTH YORK, BY ESTABLISHING AN ADDITIONAL ROADWAY UPON WHICH PARKING IS PROHIBITED UNDER CHAPTER 76, "PARKING SCHEDULES," SCHEDULE II, "PARKING PROHIBITED AT ALL TIMES IN CERTAIN LOCATIONS," AND BY ESTABLISHING AN ADDITIONAL STOP INTERSECTION UNDER CHAPTER 75, "TRAFFIC SCHEDULES," SCHEDULE VIII, "STOP INTERSECTIONS ESTABLISHED."

The Borough Council of North York Borough, York County, Pennsylvania, enacts and ordains as follows:

Section 1. Schedule II, "Parking Prohibited at All Time in Certain Locations," of Chapter 76, "Parking Schedules," of Title VII, "Traffic Code," is hereby amended by the addition of the following:

<i>Street</i>	<i>Side</i>	<i>Between</i>
East 5 th Avenue	South	Queen Street and North Duke Street

Section 2. Schedule VIII, "Stop Intersections Established," of Chapter 75, "Traffic Schedules," of Title VII, "Traffic Code," is hereby amended by the addition of the following to Subpart A:

<i>Stop Street</i>	<i>Intersecting or Through Street</i>	<i>Direction of Travel</i>
North Duke Street	4 th Avenue	South

Section 3. Severability.

It is hereby declared to be the legislative intent that if a court of competent jurisdiction declares any provisions of this Ordinance to be invalid, the effect of such decision shall be limited to those provisions which are expressly stated in the decision to be invalid. In such case, all provisions of this Ordinance that were not declared invalid shall continue to be separately and fully effective. Borough Council hereby declares that it would have passed all other parts of this Ordinance, without including any part declared invalid, if it had advance knowledge that such part would be declared invalid. If the entire Ordinance should be declared invalid, then the previous

Ordinance that was in effect immediately prior to the enactment of this Ordinance shall automatically be re-instated as the Ordinance for North York Borough.

Section 4. Procedural Defects in Enactment.

Allegations that this Ordinance or any amendment was enacted in a procedurally defective manner shall be appealed as provided in Pennsylvania law.

Section 5. Repealer.

Any provisions of the previous Ordinance that are inconsistent or incompatible with this Ordinance are hereby repealed and all other Borough ordinances or parts thereof that are inconsistent or incompatible herewith are repealed to the extent of such inconsistency or incompatibility. This Repealer clause shall only repeal Borough Ordinances or parts thereof that were adopted prior to this Ordinance and that are clearly in direct conflict with this Ordinance.

Section 6. Enactment.

This Ordinance shall become effective on 1/12, 2022.
