AN ORDINANCE DESIGNATING UNION FIRE DEPARTMENT No. 23 AS THE
PRIMARY PROVIDER OF FIRE PROTECTION AND UPMC AS THE PRIMARY
PROVIDER OF BASIC/ADVANCED LIFE SUPPORT SERVICES FOR NORTH YORK
BOROUGH, YORK COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

ORDINANCE NO. 2022-02

WHEREAS, the Borough of North York has an active volunteer fire department known as Union Fire Department No. 23, and also an active emergency services provider known as UPMC; and

WHEREAS, Union Fire Department No. 23 provides fire service and UPMC provides ambulance and rescue service within the region of the Borough of North York; and

WHEREAS, under Section 1202 of the PA Borough Code, Borough Council has the specific power to enter into an agreement for such services by ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council of North York deems it necessary and right to enter into agreement for such services for the protection of its citizenry;

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby Ordained and Enacted by the Borough Council of North York, York County, Pennsylvania, that:

SECTION 1. DESIGNATION OF PROVIDER OF BASIC/ADVANCED LIFE SUPPORT SERVICES AND FIRE PROTECTION

Union Fire Department No. 23, headquartered in Manchester, Pennsylvania, is hereby designated as the primary provider of fire protection in and for the Borough of North York. UPMC is hereby designated as the primary provider of basic/advanced life support services in and for the Borough of North York.

SECTION 2. NOTIFICATION OF DESIGNATION

The Regional EMS Council and the York County Communications Center shall be notified of the above designation, by the forwarding to such organizations of a certified copy of the present Ordinance.

SECTION 3. ENFORCEABILITY AND REPEALER

If any section, clause, provision or portion of this ordinance shall be held invalid or unconstitutional by any Court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect any other section, clause, provision or portion of this ordinance so long as it remains legally enforceable minus the invalid portion. The Borough reserves the right to amend this ordinance or any portion thereof from time to time as it shall deem advisable in the best interests of the promotion of the purposes & intent of this ordinance, & the effective administration thereof. All ordinances or parts of ordinances that are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.


SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE


This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect in accordance with Section 3301.3 (b) of the Borough Code.


