A RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH OF NORTH YORK, YORK COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, TO FILL A VACANCY IN ELECTED BOROUGH OFFICE

WHEREAS a vacancy in the office of Councilor of the Borough of NORTH YORK, County of YORK has occurred due to a resignation; death; failure to take the required oath or termination of residency; and

WHEREAS Section 901 (8 PS § 901 (a)) of the Borough Code provides that the borough shall fill such vacancy by resolution within thirty (30) days by appointing a registered elector of the borough (who has also resided one year continuously prior to the date of appointment) to hold such office until the first Monday in January after the first Municipal Election occurring more than sixty (60) days after the vacancy occurs at which election an eligible person shall be elected to the office for the remainder of the term.

WHEREAS the next Municipal Election will be held in November 2023.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that M. Joel Collier, a registered elector of the Borough of NORTH YORK is hereby appointed to the office of Councilor of the Borough of NORTH YORK, to serve until December 31, 2023.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that there shall be elected at the next Municipal Election, which shall occur in November 2023, a qualified elector of the Borough of NORTH YORK to hold such office from the first Monday in January 2024 until December 31, 2027.
